**Essential educational items:** Items, activities, or services that the school deems **essential** to student learning of the standard curriculum.

- **Compass** – a web based management system for parents and students to access learning tasks, homework, timetables, reports, and to communicate with teachers
- **Mathletics** – a comprehensive Numeracy resource for VCAL students which can also be accessed at home for revision, consolidation and extension of skills
- **Technology subjects** incur material costs (**payment is requested prior to the commencement of the subject**)
- **Art** - provision of additional materials (above the standard curriculum) to ensure students have the opportunity to experience a diverse and exciting range of art medium
- **Visual Communication Design** - provision of additional materials to ensure students have the opportunity to design and construct a unique and interesting product
- **VET subjects** incur material costs (**payment is requested prior to the commencement of the subject**) \*Due to these subjects being provided externally, there may be a cost adjustment.

**Optional items:** Items, activities or services that are **optional** and offered **in addition to the standard curriculum**. Students may access these on a **user-pays** basis.

- **Camps/Excursions/Incursions** – TBA
- **Outdoor Education** – provision of resources required for the program
- **Dhudhuroa Language Dictionary** – retain from previous year, or purchase from the College Office
- **Safety glasses for Product Design and Technology** – retain from previous year or purchase from the College Office

**Voluntary financial contributions:** Whilst these are discretionary payments, we invite parents to consider further supporting the College in the following areas:

- **College Development Fund** – further development/refurbishment of school buildings
- **Library Enhancement Fund** – expand/upgrade Library resources
- **General Donation** – provision of additional resources/opportunities for students
- **Sport contribution** – to reduce costs of excursions
- **Outdoor Education contribution** - support Outdoor Education equipment
